1.0 Call to Order

- 1.1 **Welcome and Introductions:** Chair Eddie welcomed everyone to the November Resident Council and turned the meeting over to the Recording Secretary Lynne To review Last Month's minutes

 - **6.1 Education Item: RTLS with Jake:** Eddie read a report from Jake reminding the residents how to use their RTLS badges. A resident commented that health care aides need to respond quicker. Eddie said he will look into it.
 - **6.2 Nursing Report**. 3rd dose of the COVID19 vaccine was administered on October 25th. 83% of our residents were given the 3rd dose. 90% of the residents were given the flu shot. Susan and Karen did a flu shot clinic for the staff. Covid cases are picking up. Break Through infections are happening. 138 in hospital, 38 in ICU, Luther Home had a surprise Standards visit in which we did very well in.
 - 6.3 **Dietary and Housekeeping Report**. Eddie read a report from Krista. She wrote that the new fall menu is up. She wanted to know what Ethnic theme they wanted for lunch. The residents voted and picked Chinese.
 - **Maintenance and Laundry Report:** Doug was unable to come to the meeting so Eddie asked if the residents had any questions or comments. A resident said her room was too hot, another resident said her

- room was to cold because she sleeps right under a vent. Eddie said he would pass this information onto Doug.
- **Spiritual Care Report:** Pastor David read off the Spiritual care report. He said "We endeavor to do is to make my presence known." He is trying to achieve this with the residents. He is always here for the residents spiritually. He is so happy that the leadership has one thing on their mind and that is to open our hearts and working as a team.
- 6.6 Recreation Report: Eddie read off the Recreation Report. He asked the residents how they enjoyed the Oktoberfest party. Residents really enjoyed it especially the soft pretzels.
