



Update for Families February 23, 2022

While COVID-19 remains a risk to the health and wellness of our Residents, our high vaccine uptake, combined with the decreasing level of transmission of the virus in the community, has allowed for a phased loosening of visitor restrictions at Luther Home.

We are very pleased to see the current pandemic situation stabilizing and look forward to once again welcoming family and friends into Luther Home for visits, celebrations and activities. Visitor access will expand gradually over the next several weeks and we thank you for your patience, cooperation and respect as this access changes and evolves. The timing of these changes will be different from the changes that occur in public settings and we will ensure you have up-to-date and accurate information about changes that affect your visits. Additionally, public health protections such as health screening, vaccinations, PPE, and physical distancing will continue to be mandatory for anyone entering Luther Home.

While changes to visitor access will not happen all at once, effective **Thursday, February 24, 2022**, the first phase of expanded visitor access will occur. This phase includes welcoming back Designated Family Visitors for In-room Visits and General Visitors for Pod Visits.

Designated Family Visitors can visit in the Resident's room without an appointment (walk in) on Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 11:45 am to 3:15pm; and Wednesdays and Thursdays from 3:00pm to 6:30pm. The number of Designated Family Visitors has now increased to six (6) people per Resident. New Designated Family Visitors must register and provide proof of vaccination prior to visiting under this grouping.

General Visitors can call and make an appointment to visit Residents in the Pod on Tuesdays through Saturdays. Evening, afternoon and morning appointments for General Visitors can be booked during regular business hours (Mon-Fri 9am - 4pm) by calling (431) 336-1882.
