**1.0 Call to Order**

1.1 **Welcome and Introductions:** Chair Eddie Marion-Gerula welcomed everyone to the April, 2022 Resident Council meeting and turned the meeting over to Recording Secretary Lynne Stevens.

Eddie explained we still are not allowed to sing in the facility but once the weather gets nicer we will have entertainment in the courtyard.

6.4 **Wish List Items Completed:** 0 was completed as last Resident Council there was nothing on the wish list.

6.5 **Education Item: Resident's Bill of Rights:** Eddie reviewed the Resident's Bill of Rights. **The residents accepted the Residents Bill of Rights and had no questions.**

- 6.6 Nursing Report:** No questions or concerns were brought forward. Eddie explained there will be a 2<sup>nd</sup> booster coming out for residents who have not had COVID yet near the end of April, 2022.
- 6.7 **Dietary and Housekeeping:** Some items such pudding and Saran wrap are still hard to come by. There will be a Mother's Day BBQ May 9, 2022.
- 6.8 Report. Maintenance and Laundry Report:** No questions or concerns were brought forward.
- 6.9 Spiritual Care Report:** Pastor David did the Spiritual report. He explained we went through an outbreak and we beat it together. Pastor David explained he gets to know each resident by their story telling.
- 6.10 Recreation Report:** Eddie read the Recreation Report. He asked the residents how they enjoyed the 2 weeks of Olympic activities. The residents really enjoyed the program and said they loved the activities and the medals. We will be decorating eggs this week and doing an Easter Party. We will be doing a Mother's Day party. A resident asked if we could have more drumfit. Eddie said of course we can! Eddie said we will continue to wear masks in programs and stay 6 feet apart as much as we can.

- 6.12 Outbreak:** 2/3 of our residents caught COVID. It was a tough time as we were stuck in your rooms for about a month. Eddie said but we made it through together and were proud of how everyone came together in such a difficult time. Eddie said he had to add something to the agenda which was the winter storm coming. Eddie explained we are ready for the storm we have enough supplies and food on hand. We have 4 workers with trucks who will pick up employees that can't make it in. Our generator was just tested and is working and will run all power outlets in the facility and is full of gas. We have sleeping arrangements for staff in case they have to stay overnight.
- 6.13 New President:** Sadly we lost our President Larry Smith so our Vice President Janice Whitchard will step in as President until September. In September we will vote in a new President and Vice President.
- 6.14 Hairdressing:** Eddie introduced our new hairdresser Amanda. Residents are very happy with her work so far. She will be opened Tuesday and Thursday from 9-3.

Eddie said yes nothing has changed if a resident had symptoms they would be isolated and tested like before. We are still self screening wearing PPE and doing our constant audits. Another family member said to keep up the good work.
