Through exceptional work and dedication by the entire Luther Home Team, I am pleased to report that the **COVID-19 Outbreak** that was declared at Luther Home Personal Care Home on March 7, 2022 has been deemed **Resolved** effective today, April 2, 2022.

The past twenty-seven days have been extremely demanding on all of our Staff, who have gone to extraordinary measures to keep our Residents safe from this very contagious variant. The two year preparation for this battle with COVID on our home turf served us well as the performance of our Care and Support Teams was truly phenomenal. No words can express my appreciation and admiration for the amazing people who pulled together to push this deadly foe out of our Home. We are very Blessed at Luther Home!

With the resolution of this Outbreak, Luther Home will begin our return to a more normal way of life. All Residents will now be able to leave their rooms for meals and recreation programming (still at a distance and masked when tolerated). Further changes to visitation are also planned for next week and will be communicated to families and loved ones when those changes occur.

We will continue to monitor and test Residents and Staff for the presence of COVID-19. There is a new variant emerging and we must remain vigilant to protect both Residents and Staff. It is also important to note that should an outbreak reoccur, a return to outbreak protocols will be necessary. If there is a change in our outbreak status we will notify all families and stakeholders immediately.

We appreciate that you may have many questions at this time but we ask that you hold off on calling Luther Home until after the weekend, so that our Nurses can focus on Resident care. Your patience and understanding are appreciated as we move on to a new normal. Thank you.
